The REU/URE program objective is to promote the professional development of minority undergraduate students through their participation in science research. The program consists of undergraduate students from minority serving institutions; each student was assigned to a specific research team, where they worked closely with a faculty mentor. In addition, seminars, lunch meetings, and social functions were organized to facilitate undergraduate interaction. The project was conducted for eight weeks during summer 2016, with online mentoring and follow-up during the academic year 2016-2017. In addition to the six students at ECSU during summer 2016, Indiana University (Dr. Geoffrey Fox, Co-PI) hosted four students, two students and two educators were assigned to NASA LaRC, University of Kansas (Dr. Prasad Gogineni Co-PI) hosted seven students and two students were accepted into the Juneau Icefield Research Program (JIRP).
