Her internship experience included Modeling and Simulation of the Seismic TET walker Concept, Correlations between the Concentrations of Chlorophyll a in Surface Waters and Dissolved Oxygen in Boom Waters of the Northern Gulf of Mexico, Airborne Measurement of Snow Thickness over Sea Ice, and Using Passive Network Discovery to Fingerprint Vulnerabilities within Ethernet Broadcast Frames. She also gave advice on gaining, maintaining, keeping an open mind before, during, and after the internship. She gave valuable pointers on how to go about finding an internship, how you should conduct yourself during the internship, that you may leave on good terms and have a lasting impact on that company to get called back.
