### Dr. Denise Johnson

Denise Johnson is an Associate Professor of Education at Winston-Salem State University where she is coordinator of both the undergraduate and MAT Middle Grades Education program. She earned an Ed.D. in Curriculum and Instruction from The George Washington University, and an M.S. in Mathematics Education and a B.S. in Mathematics from North Carolina State University. Prior to serving at Winston-Salem State University, she was an Assistant Professor in Mathematics Education at the University of North Carolina Wilmington.

Her research areas and publications focus on girls in STEM, Computational Thinking, and informal learning environments in STEM all which are generated from activity in the three community-based youth programs that she directs.

Dr. Johnson has received a number of grants such as: Honda, Black Philanthropy Initiative, BB&T, American Communities Trust, and Z. Smith Reynolds to fund her Outreach programs.
