## What is a smartphone?

a cellular phone that performs many of the functions of a computer, typically having a touchscreen interface, Internet access, and an operating system capable of running downloaded applications

### <u>A SmartPhone</u>

#### What is a Smartphone,

a mobile phone that performs many of the functions of a computer, typically having a touchscreen interface, Internet access, and an operating system capable of running downloaded apps.



## What is a Tablet?

A tablet is a wireless, portable personal computer with a touch screen interface. The tablet form factor is typically smaller than a notebook computer but larger than a smartphone.



### Anatomy of a Smartphone



Lock Screenfirst screen that you see when your phone or tablet powers up





Home Screen-This screen is the initial screen you see after you unlock your device. It displays all of the applications available to you on this device



### Navigational Icons for Smartphones and Tablets

Name	Function
Back	Go back, close, or dismiss the onscreen keyboard.
Home	Go to the Home screen.
Recent	Display recently opened apps.
	Back Home

#### More Computer Terms

Icon- a small picture or image representing a command, a file, or a program. When you click on an icon, you start a command, open a file, or launch a program.
