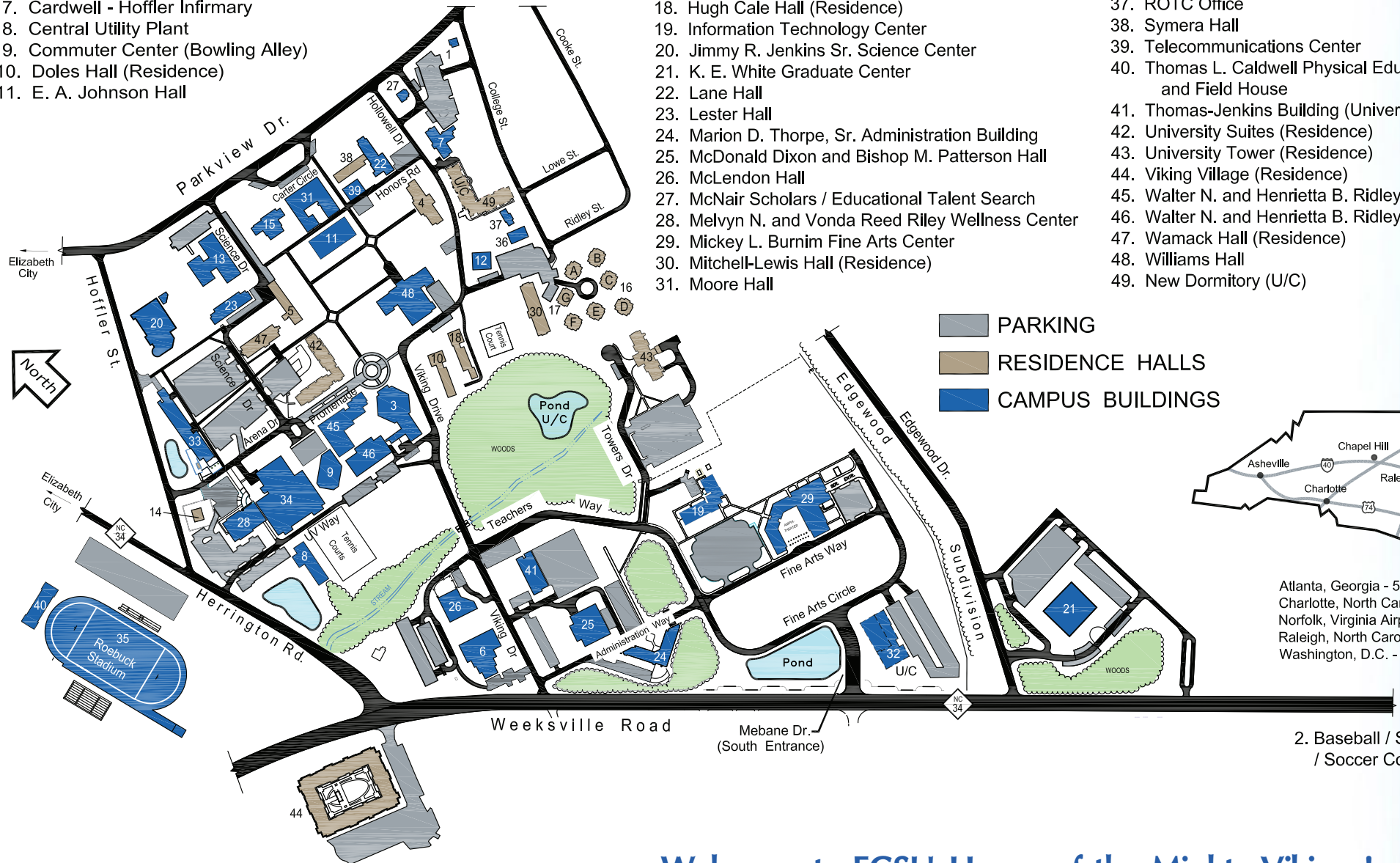
Elizabeth City State University Campus Map
